SCIENCE AND EMPIRES: FROM THE INTERNATIONAL COLLOQUIUM TO THE BOOK Patrick PETITJEAN, Catherine JAMI and Anne Marie MOULIN The International Colloquium "Science and Empires - Historical Studies about Scientific Development and European Expansion" is the product of an International Colloquium, "Sciences and Empires - A Comparative History of Scientific Exchanges: European Expansion and Scientific Development in Asian, African, American and Oceanian Countries". Organized by the REHSEIS group (Research on Epistemology and History of Exact Sciences and Scientific Institutions) of CNRS (National Center for Scientific Research), the colloquium was held from 3 to 6 April 1990 in the UNESCO building in Paris. This colloquium was an idea of Professor Roshdi Rashed who initiated this field of studies in France some years ago, and proposed "Sciences and Empires" as one of the main research programmes for the The project to organize such a colloquium was a bit REHSEIS group. of a gamble. Its subject, reflected in the title "Sciences and Empires", is not a currently-accepted sub-discipline of the history of science; rather, it refers to a set of questions which found autonomy only recently. The terminology was strongly debated by the participants and, as is frequently suggested in this book, awaits fuller clarification.

Recent determination of genome sequences for a wide range of bacteria has made in-depth knowledge of prokaryotic metabolic function essential in order to give biochemical, physiological, and ecological meaning to the genomic information. Clearly describing the important metabolic processes that occur in prokaryotes under different conditions and in different environments, this advanced text provides an overview of the key cellular processes that determine bacterial roles in the environment, biotechnology, and human health. Prokaryotic structure is described as well as the means by which nutrients are transported into cells across membranes. Glucose metabolism through glycolysis and the TCA cycle are discussed, as well as other trophic variations found in prokaryotes, including the use of organic compounds, anaerobic fermentation, anaerobic respiratory processes, and photosynthesis. The regulation of metabolism through control of gene expression and control of the activity of enzymes is also covered, as well as survival mechanisms used under starvation conditions.

Medical Physiology: Principles for Clinical Medicine richly presents the physiology knowledge necessary for clinical

practice. Along with the latest information on how the human body reacts to internal and external changes, the text provides a deep understanding of how physiologic systems coordinate to maintain optimal health. Conceptual diagrams facilitate comprehension of difficult concepts and presents both normal and abnormal clinical conditions. Active Learning Objectives, Chapter Summaries, and full-color artwork and tables facilitate learning and study. A companion website offers additional resources for students including animations, additional review questions, additional clinical application exercises, advanced clinical problem-solving exercises, and suggested readings.

Coverage of physiopathology, in addition to clinical problem-solving techniques, makes this resource uniquely relevant to practice. Esta nueva edición ha adquirido nuevos recursos didácticos, conservando a su vez el estilo tan querido por los lectores de Invitación. Cada capítulo comienza con una frase que incita al lector a reflexionar sobre los aspectos más relevantes que se desarrollan en el texto. A lo largo del libro, se han incorporado recuadros que profundizan sobre algunos de los temas mencionados en el texto; estos recuadros pueden leerse en forma independiente. En la mayoría de los capítulos se incluyeron, como en ediciones anteriores, ensayos cortos sobre diversos temas relacionados directa o indirectamente con los conceptos desarrollados. En estos ensayos, el lector encontrará debates actuales sobre problemáticas

científicas que, en ocasiones, tienen un alcance social. También se discuten aspectos de la historia de la Biología, entre otros temas de interés general. Cada capítulo finaliza con una situación problemática cuyo objetivo es poner a prueba los conocimientos adquiridos por el lector en el correspondiente capítulo. También se ha actualizado la representación gráfica de los procesos y estructuras descritos a lo largo del texto. Se han renovado además, muchas de las fotografías originales, agregando nuevas o reemplazando imágenes existentes por otras que ilustran los nuevos contenidos. A lo largo del libro, se ha privilegiado un ordenamiento lógico, que permite construir los conceptos en forma paulatina, en la medida en que ciertos temas sientan la base para otros. Pero de alguna manera, la historia de las ideas siempre está presente a lo largo de los capítulos, demostrando una y otra vez que la Biología, como toda una ciencia, no es un producto acabado. A la hora de seleccionar los temas a incorporar en esta nueva edición, se ha tenido en cuenta su relevancia, su capacidad de ilustrar principios biológicos básicos y su importancia como parte necesaria de la cultura general de un ciudadano. También se ha considerado el atractivo inherente que tienen esos temas. Pero sobre todo, se ha tratado de sentar cimientos firmes sobre los cuales el lector pueda construir su conocimiento biológico. El eje principal de este libro sigue siendo, como lo fue desde sus comienzos, la evolución que es el eje alrededor del cual se estructura toda la Biología. En torno a ese eje, se organizan la Introducción y las ocho Secciones de este libro.

Biología funcional de los animales tiene el objeto de ofrecer un panorama introductorio de fisiología general y comparada en un contexto ambiental. En este libro se estudian tanto aspectos actuales de fisiología celular como mecanismos de regulación y control con un nivel de complejidad orgánico, además de las relaciones de los organismos con el medio ambiente (osmorregularización y temperatura); se resumen y actualizan también los conceptos clásicos de homeostasis y control.

This handbook is intended as an introductory guide to students at all levels on the principles and practice of plant growth analysis. Many have found this quantitative approach to be useful in the description and interpretation of the performance of whole plant systems grown under natural, semi-natural or controlled conditions. Most of the methods described require only simple experimental data and facilities. For the classical approach, GCSE biology and mathematics (or their equivalents) are the only theoretical backgrounds required. For the functional approach, a little calculus and statistical theory is needed. All of the topics regarding the quantitative basis of productivity recently introduced to the Biology A-level syllabus by the Joint Matriculation Board are covered. The booklet replaces my elementary Plant Growth Analysis (1978, London: Edward Arnold) which is now out of print. The presentation is very basic indeed; the opening pages give only essential outlines of the main issues. They are followed by brief, standardized accounts of each growth-analytical concept taken in turn. The illustrations deal more with the properties of well-grown material than with the effects of specific environmental changes, even though that is where much of the subject's interest lies. However, detailed references to the relevant parts of more comprehensive works appear throughout, and a later section on 'Inter relations' adds perspective. Some 'Questions and answers' may also help to show what topics will arise if the subject is pursued further.

La enseñanza de la Fisiología Animal en las Facultades de Biología suele presentar el problema de que, aunque existen

numerosos y excelentes textos traducidos, el alumno necesita utilizar al menos dos, uno de Fisiología Humana y otro de Fisiología Comparada. El presente manual no puede ser sustitutorio de una Fisiología comparada, pero sí un buen complemento de un texto de Fisiología Humana, introduciendo algunos materiales generalmente ausentes de los textos de Fisiología Comparada, hallazgos recientes aún incorporados a los mismos datos correspondientes al área de Bioquímica Comparada. En efecto, la fusión entre Fisiología y Bioquímica Animal se hace cada vez más inevitable cuando se habla de adaptación, especialmente con los avances cada vez más rápidos en nuestra comprensión del inmenso mundo de los animales ectotermos. Pero, por encima de todo, el trabajo del autor constituye un ensayo sobre la contribución que la Fisiología puede hacer a la comprensión del gran fenómeno biológico que es el hecho evolutivo. Una crítica del antropocentrismo biológico, afirmándose correlativamente el principio científico de objetividad de la naturaleza, y una invitación a la polémica entre pensadores, tanto de ramas científicas como del campo de las humanidades.
